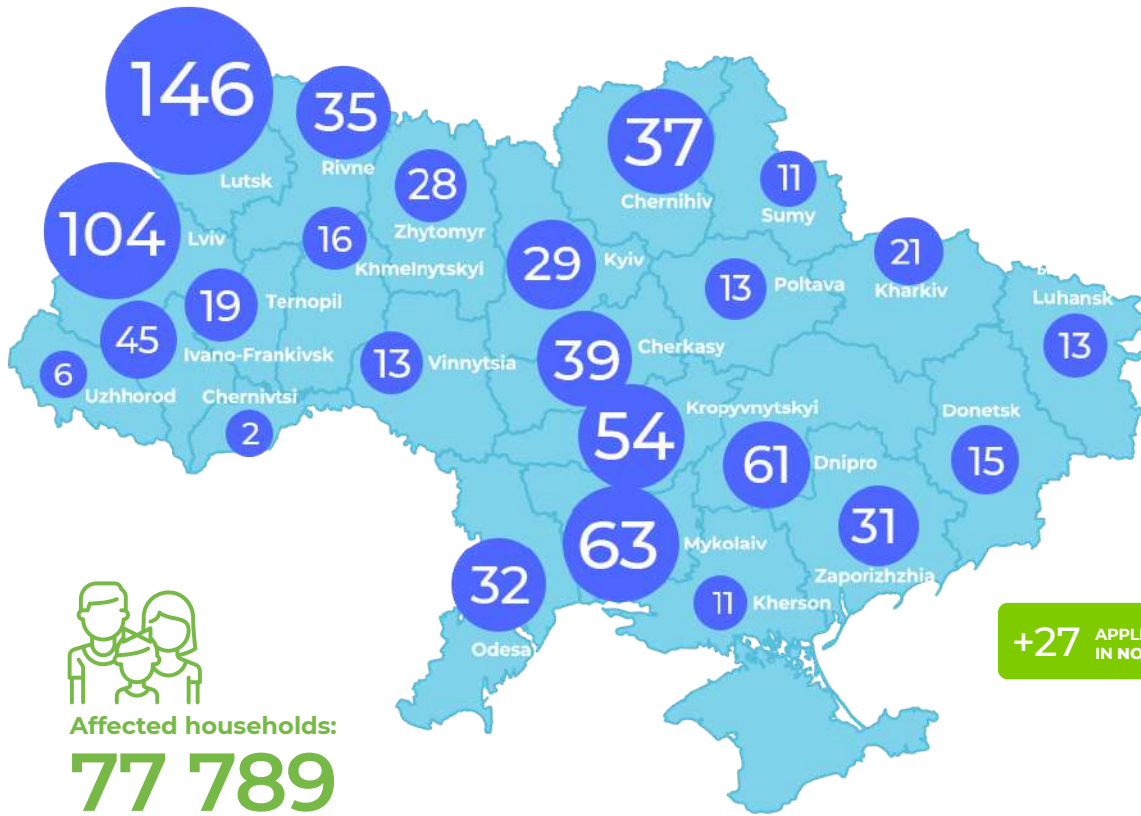

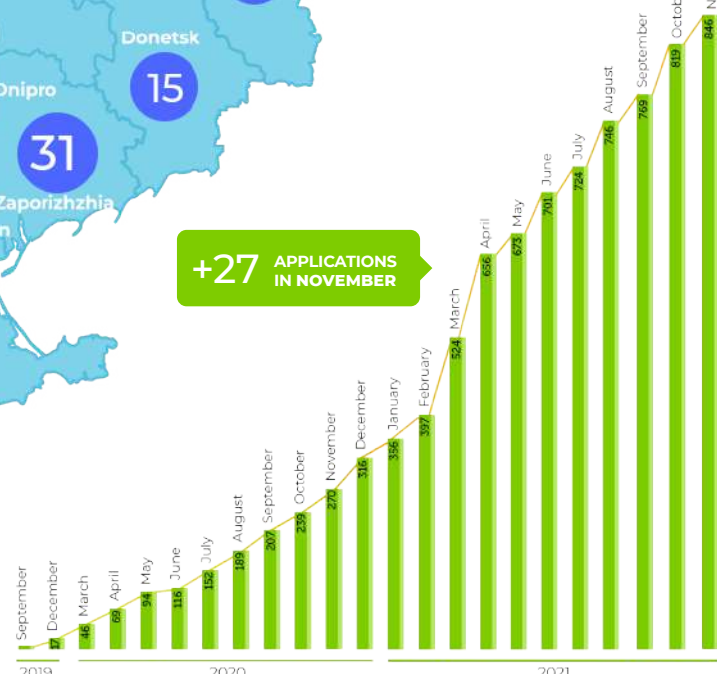

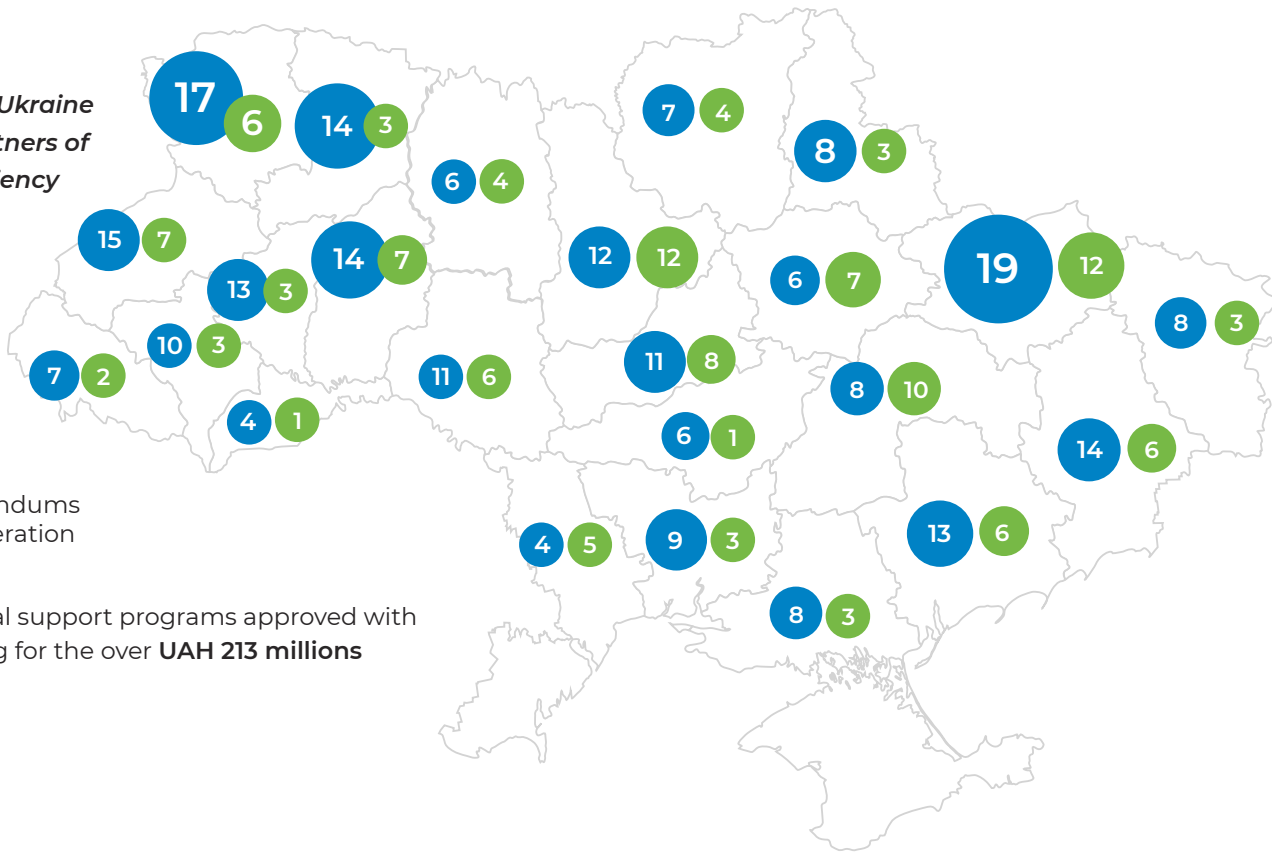

The EE Fund continued the succession of demonstrational trips to different regions of Ukraine

Aim: representing the completed projects on energy renovation of the multifamily buildings under the Energodim program to the local co-owners and media.

Trip to Svitlovodsk was made in November

Participants: more than 25 co-owners-potential participants of the Energodim program from Kropyvnytskyi, Oleksandriya and Zhamyanka, Kirovohrad Region, representatives of municipalities, IFC regional advisors.

The project cost makes:

UAH 91.8 million

- More than 1480 HOA's have been created in Odessa.
- The EE Fund signed a memorandum on cooperation with the Odessa City Council in October 2019.
- On November 3, 2021, the City Council of Odessa amended the program of assistance to condominiums, and increased its financial assistance for energy modernization with the following amounts:
 - 20%, up to UAH 500,000 under package "A" (out of 501 applications),
 - 30%, up to UAH 2,500,000 under package "B" (all applications), incl. step-by-step verification costs are covered.
- Program budget per year: 2021 - UAH 2 million, 2022 - UAH 8 million.





Main events in November 2021



Site visits to houses renovated by HOAs participating in Energodim program in Khmelnytskyi and Zhytomyr

- In November, the Fund showcased two MFB thermal renovation projects performed under the Energodim Program.
- The site visits were led by Yehor Fareniuk, acting Head of the Energy Efficiency Fund, as part of Oleksii Chernyshov's, Minister of Development of Communities and Territories of Ukraine, working visit to Zhytomyr and Khmelnytskyi oblasts.
- During the tour the delegation visited Khmelnytskyi HOA "Franka 55" and Zhytomyr HOA "Kyivska 47", retrofitted under the Energodim program

Revisions to Energodim Program

- The EE Fund's Supervisory board approved tenth version of the Energodim program on November 18, 2021, with a majority of the latest amendments coming into force on November 29.
- Key revisions mandate i) a review of the Construction Works Transfer and Acceptance Act (form КБ-2в) by independent experts, e.g., forensic engineers or state experts, and ii) examination of project design documentation by state expert organizations.
