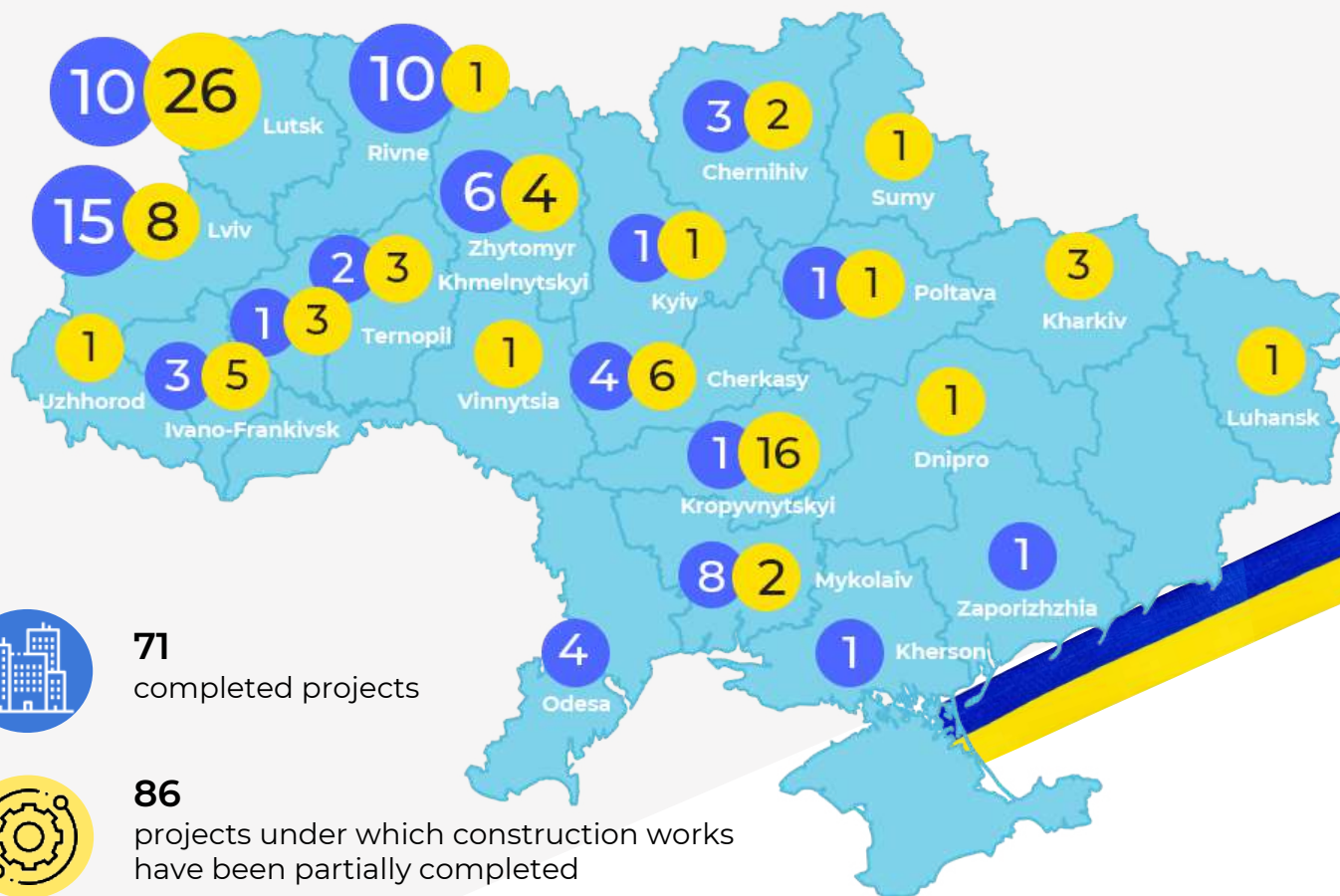

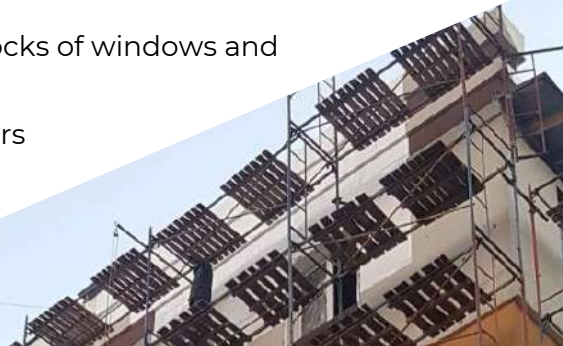

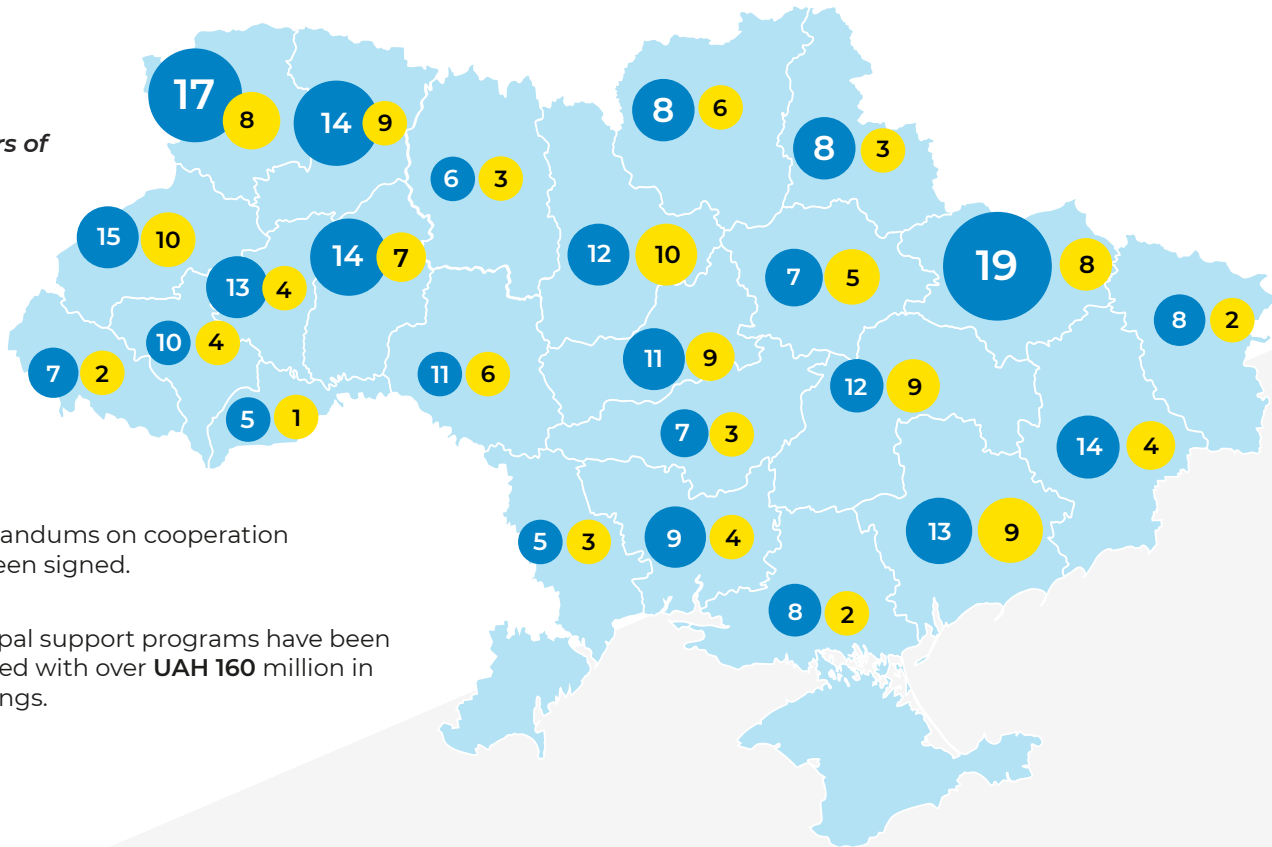
The implemented measures:

As of the beginning of 2023, **131** active municipal support programs approved with financing for the over **UAH 399 million**. In particular, with regard to **26 programs**, a decision was made to allocate funds from local budgets in the amount of **UAH 97 million** to support HOAs for the implementation of energy-efficient projects under the 'ENERGODIM' Program (for the current year).
