#Energy efficient region: Oleksandria city

In the city there are:

33 projects

The project cost makes:

UAH 547,7 million

- There are **77 HOAs** in the city.
- The EE Fund signed a memorandum on cooperation with the Oleksandria City Council in September 2020.
- On August 31, 2021, the City Council of Oleksandria approved the Program of joint financing and support of HOAs in the Oleksandria Territorial Community for 2021-2025, which also applies to ENERGO DIM Program participants. Under the city program, up to 20% of the principal amount of the loan is currently reimbursed, but not more than UAH 100,000 under one loan agreement (up to 10% of the loan amount upon re-application).
- In 2021, the city program compensated more than **280 thousand UAH for 6 HOAs**.
- Program budget for 2022 is **1.5 million UAH**.

Meeting of the Fund with the Confederation of Builders of Ukraine (KBU)

Yegor Farenjuk, director of the Energy Efficiency Fund, reported during a meeting with KBU that the Fund plans to create a Marketplace, which will be an open platform for participants in the market of thermal modernization of buildings.

On this platform, condominiums participating in the Energodim program will be able to find contractors for employment and equipment, and manufacturers will be able to offer their materials and services.

Initiation of cooperation between the Energy Efficiency Fund and the Kyiv City Council

At the meeting, the parties discussed the possibility of signing a memorandum as an important step to increase the number of energy-modernized residential buildings in the capital.

Deputies supported the bill on creating conditions for the introduction of comprehensive thermal modernization of buildings in Ukraine. Its adoption will significantly simplify the process of energy modernization of buildings under the Energodim program.
