

The authorized capital of the Fund has been increased to over UAH 2.8 billion

- On September 22, the Government of Ukraine allocated UAH 100 million from the state budget to increase the authorized capital of the Energy Efficiency Fund and thus increased it to more than UAH 2.8 billion.
- The Government also approved the draft state budget for 2022, which proposes to replenish the authorized capital of the Energy Efficiency Fund by UAH 2 billion 594 million 335 thousand.
