- · Avoided CO2 emissions: 83,4 thousand tons/year











The HOA «Solomiya-2016» from the city of Drogobych, Lviv region, implemented a Comprehensive Package of measures of the ENERGODIM Program during a full-scale war and achieved a reduction in energy consumption at about 45%.



Almost 40% savings on heating, which, according to preliminary calculations, is equal to UAH 863 thousand per year - the result of the participation of the HOA «Myrnyi 26» from the city of Yuzhne, Odesa region, in the ENERGODIM Program.
