The composition of the Supervisory Board of the Energy Efficiency Fund has been updated.

There were changes in the composition of the Supervisory Board of the EEF in 2024. Julia Sabatiuk, an independent member, has been re-elected as the Chair of the Supervisory Board. The new members of the highest governing body of the EEF are Rolf Behrndt (from international donors); Dmytro Petrunin (from the Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine); Daiva Matoniene (independent member). Also, Oleksandr Zhuk, a representative of the Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine, remains on the Supervisory Board.

The new Program called 'GreenDIM' has been created and put into operation.

The Supervisory Board of the Energy Efficiency Fund has approved a new Program 'GreenDIM' aimed at encouraging the use of alternative energy sources in multi-apartment residential buildings. This Program was put into effect on May 7, 2024.



In 2024, the Energy Efficiency Fund actively interacted with government authorities.

Throughout 2024, the Energy Efficiency Fund actively worked on strengthening both donor and government support for the implementation of its grant programs. In November 2024, Yegor Farenjuk, the CEO of the Energy Efficiency Fund, presented key achievements and challenges in each area of the EEF's activities at a meeting of the Verkhovna Rada Committee on Energy and Housing and Communal Services.

In 2024, the circle of partners of the Energy Efficiency Fund was expanded.

PJSC 'MTB Bank' and JSC 'SENSE Bank' are new partner banks of the EEF. As part of the launch of the 'Energy Source' project, a memorandum of cooperation has been signed with the Ministry of Economy of Ukraine, the Entrepreneurship Development Fund, and Sense Bank. The partnership has also been declared with the Kyiv City State Administration and the Khorol City Council. Additionally, 5 memorandums have been concluded with public organizations, municipal enterprises, and a higher education institution.



Throughout 2024, the Energy Efficiency Fund actively communicated at national, international and regional events.

The EEF's Programs were presented at 25 national-level events, 8 international events, and 30 regional events. Around 4,450 informational materials about the EEF's activities were disseminated in the media, including reports from foreign media outlets such as BBC, Estonian Public Television and France24.
