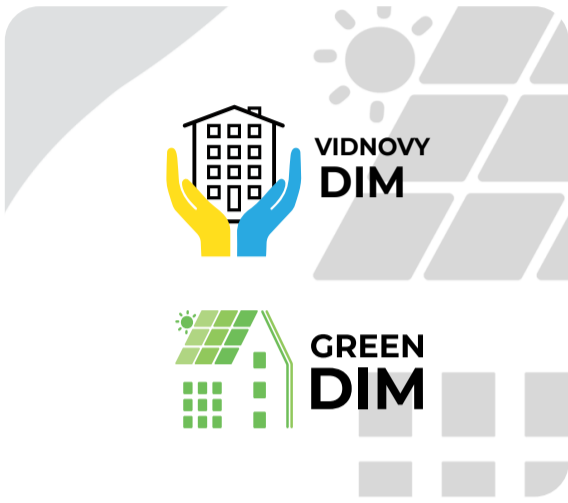

In recent months, the Energy Efficiency Fund has encountered unprecedented demand for the 'VidnovyDIM' and 'GreenDIM' Programs, as long as a record number of applications were received. Starting from March 3rd, due to limited resources, the EEF has been forced to temporarily suspend the acceptance of new applications. The Programs are not ending – the EEF is continuously working on securing additional funding to resume the application process as soon as possible.

A meeting of the sectoral working group 'Housing and Utilities' was held at the Ministry of Communities and Territories Development of Ukraine, where the results of the Energy Efficiency Fund's activity were presented for the first time. Participants discussed expanding the range of potential program participants of the EEF and coordinating efforts to adapt them to modern challenges. The event also covered key aspects of the housing reform, including compensation for destroyed housing and support for internally displaced persons (IDPs).

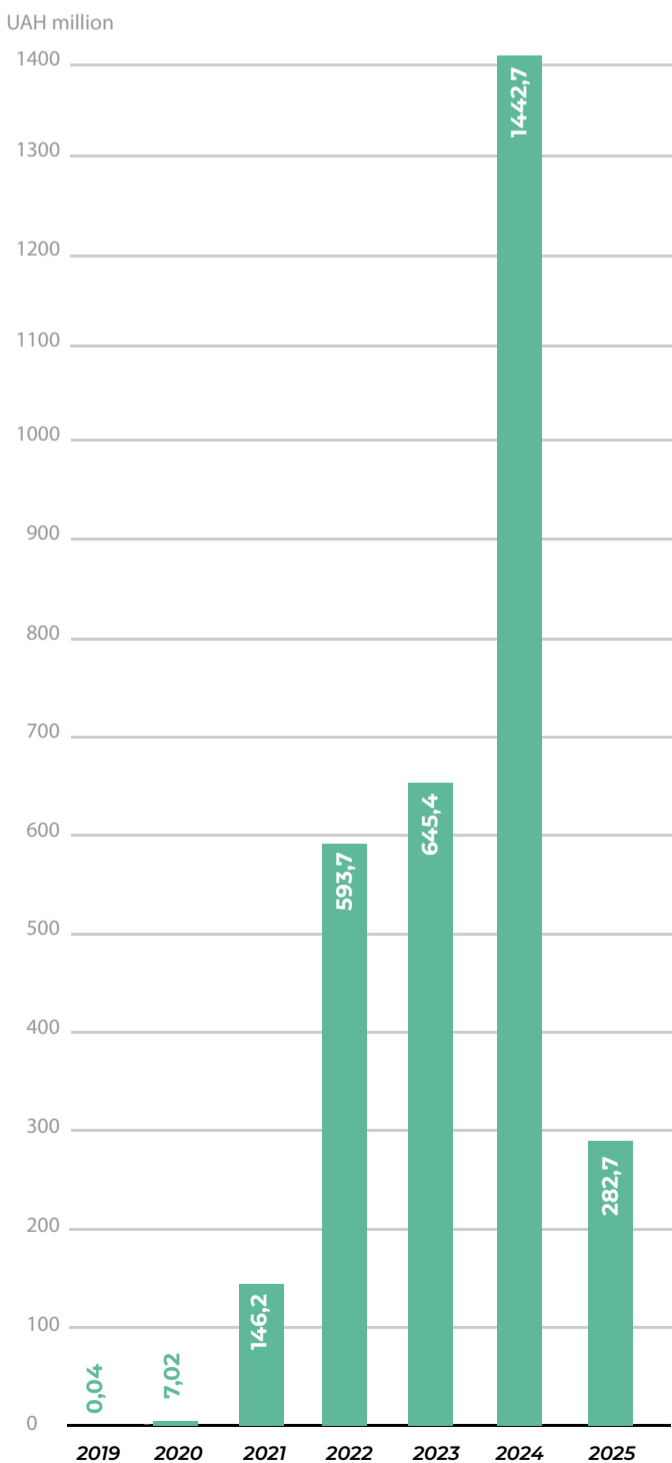

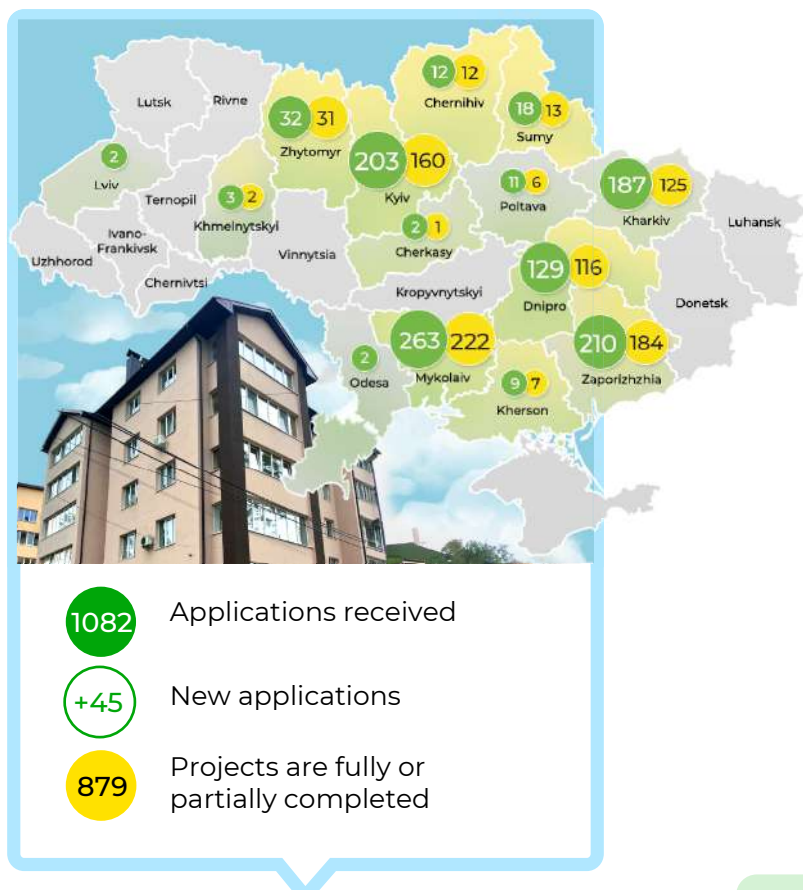

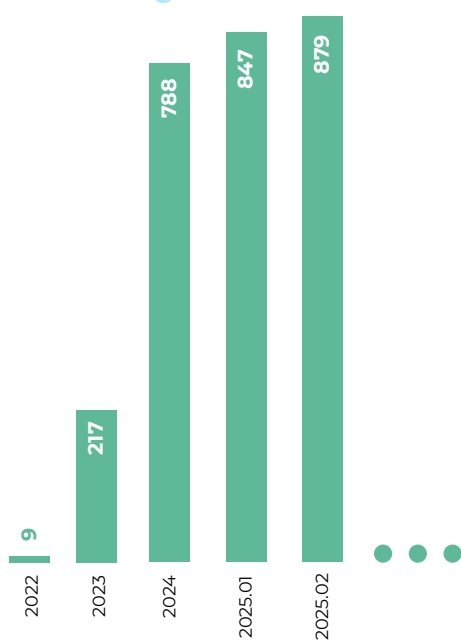

In general, the Program participants have already restored:

Window area: 199,3 thousand m²	Door area: 49,2 thousand m²
Roof area: 171,1 thousand m²	Facade area: 222,6 thousand m²

The HOA "Parity-Lisky" from Mykolaiv has restored its building under the 'VidnovyDIM' Program, having received a grant of almost UAH 5 million for replacing damaged structures and repairing the facade. Additionally, as part of the 'ENERGODIM' Program, the heating system was modernized, allowing for up to a 30% reduction in heating costs.
