The Energy Efficiency Fund has resumed accepting applications under the 'VidnovyDIM' Program — starting from July 15, damaged buildings with established homeowners associations (HOAs) can once again apply. In the new edition, the maximum grant amount has been increased to UAH 10 million, the list of eligible measures has been expanded (including the installation of individual heating points (IHP) and replacement of non-energy-efficient windows), and the payment procedure has been changed to 60/40

In July, the Energy Efficiency Fund celebrated 7 years of activity. During this time, about 1,600 projects have been implemented under the 'Energodim', 'VidnovyDIM' and 'GreenDIM' programs, more than 216,000 families have received support, and the total amount of paid grants has exceeded UAH 3.6 billion. The EEF's greatest achievement is its professional and united team, which continues to work for an energy-efficient, safe, and comfortable future for Ukraine.

In August, the Supervisory Board of the Energy Efficiency Fund approved changes to the 'Energodim' and 'VidnovyDIM' programs, opening up new opportunities for homeowners associations (HOAs). Under the 'Energodim' Program, the maximum grant amount has been increased (up to UAH 5 million for Package 'A' and up to UAH 15 million for Package 'B'), the list of measures has been expanded, step-by-step verification has been introduced, and the maximum unit costs have been updated. Under the 'VidnovyDIM' Program, the unit costs have also been revised.

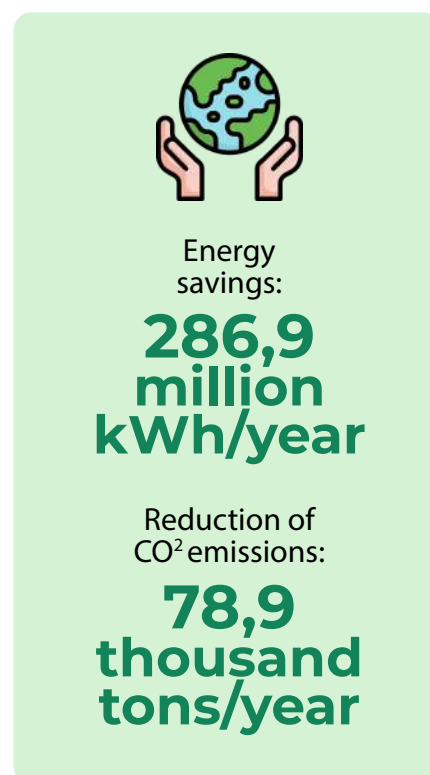
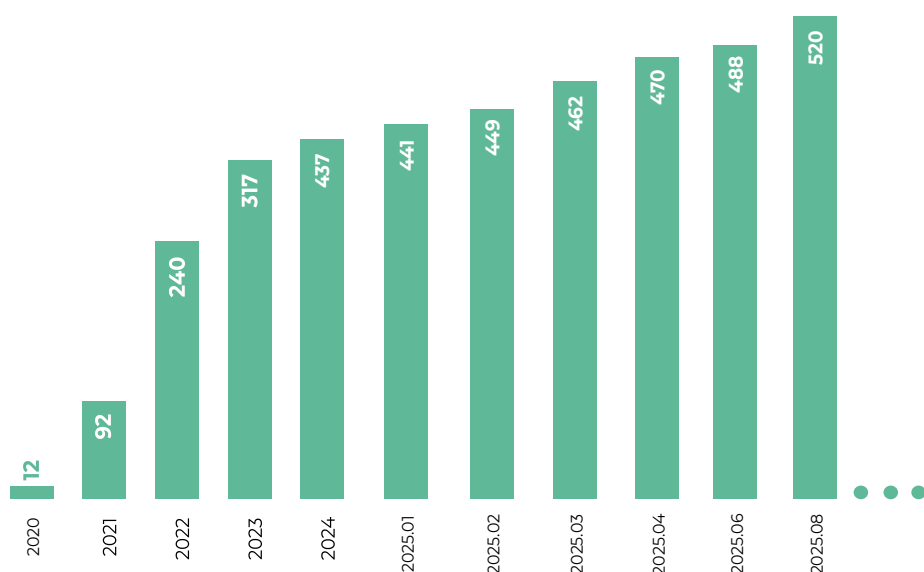
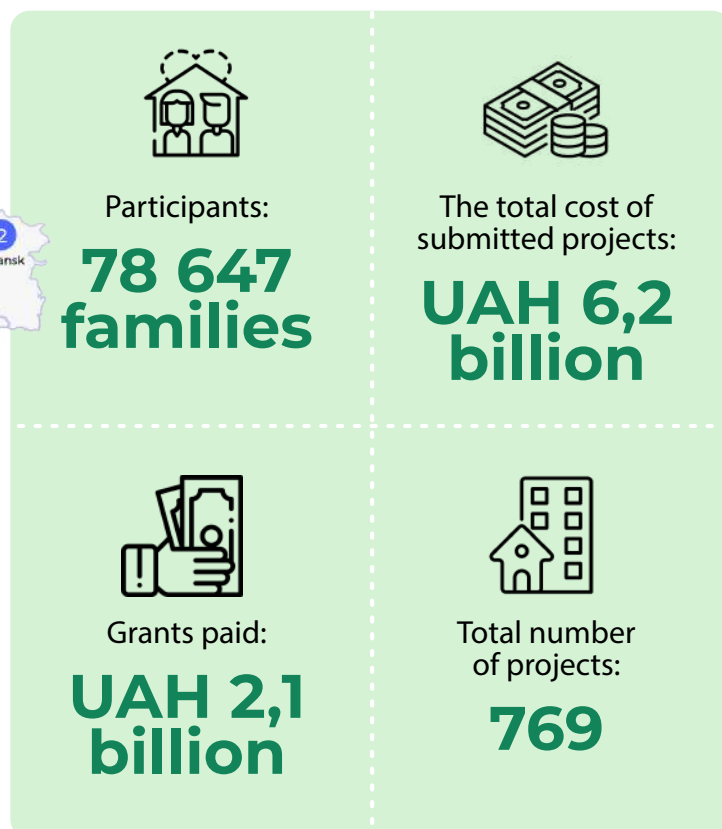
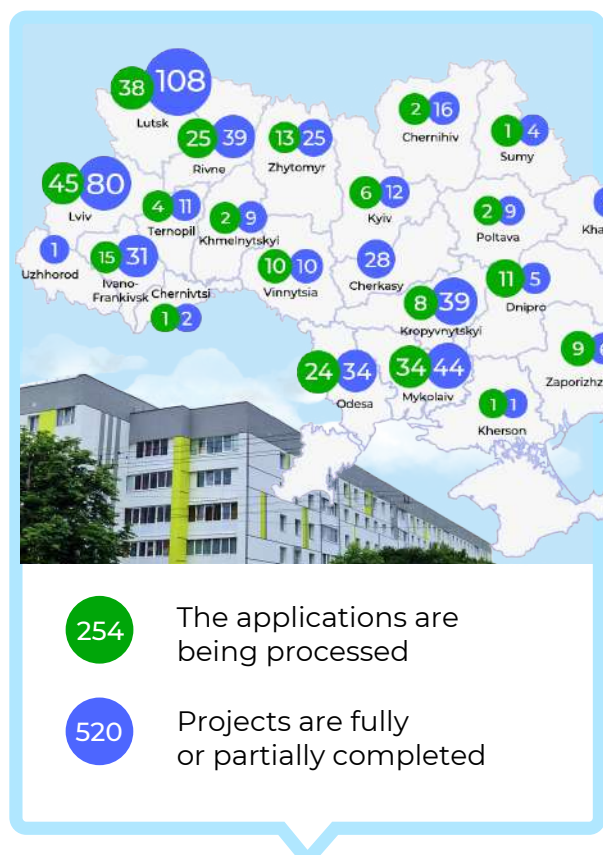


Like a Phoenix from the Ashes: The Story of HOA 'Mechnikova 103' in Irpin



Irpin has become a symbol of Ukraine's recovery, where destruction is gradually transforming to modern restored houses. One such example is the HOA 'Mechnikova 103', where, thanks to grant support from the Energy Efficiency Fund of over UAH 6.4 million, comprehensive restoration measures were carried out: the roof was repaired, facades were insulated and renovated, and windows, balcony, and entrance doors were replaced.

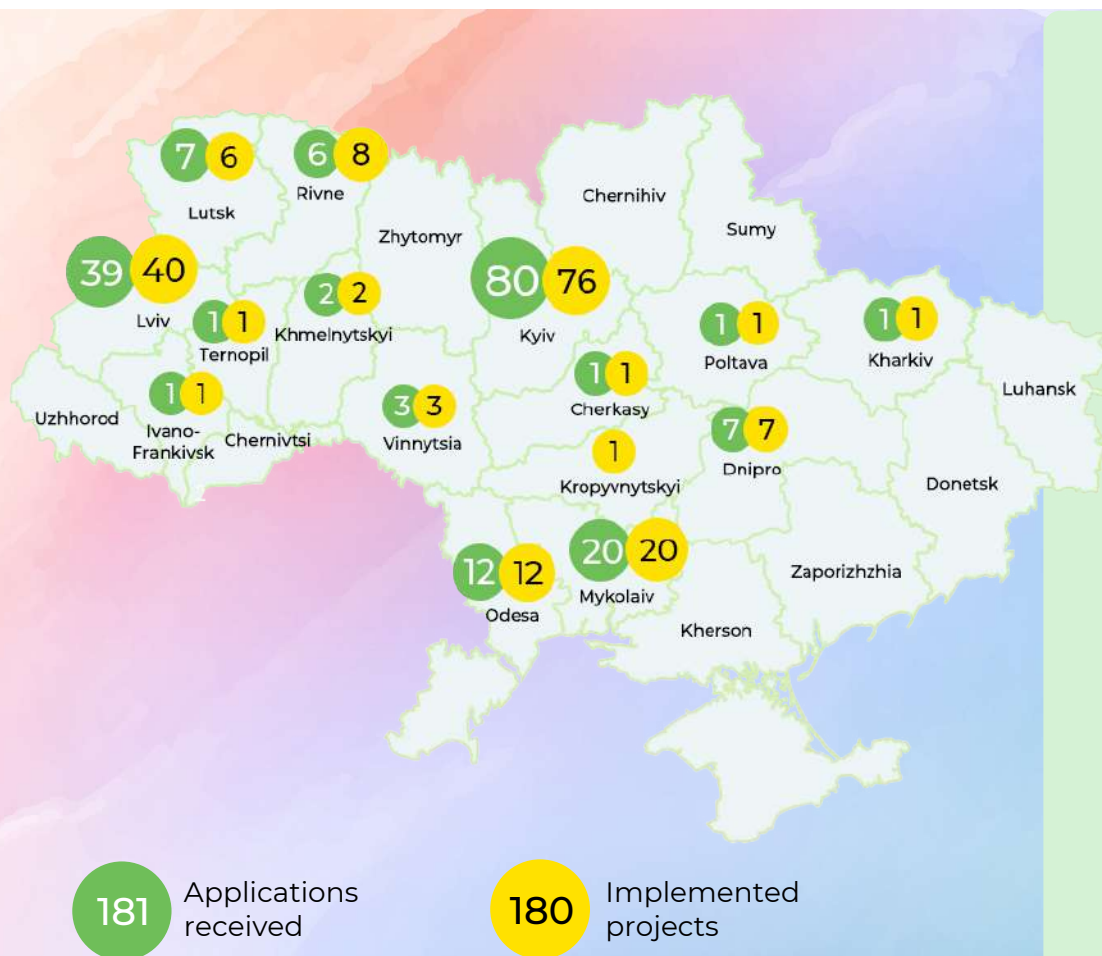


In Khmelnytskyi, apartment buildings are being modernized with the support of the 'Energodim' Program

A Step Towards Energy Independence: The Experience of HOA 'Flagman-Kharkiv'



In Kharkiv, the co-owners of the HOA 'Flagman-Kharkiv' proved that even in the most difficult conditions, it is possible to become independent and energy efficient.

Thanks to the 'GreenDIM' Program, they installed a solar power station with a 50 kW inverter, 58 kW panels, and 102.4 kWh batteries, ensuring the uninterrupted operation of all vital building systems even during prolonged outages.

The total project cost amounted to UAH 3 million, of which nearly UAH 2 million was provided to the HOA in the form of a grant.
