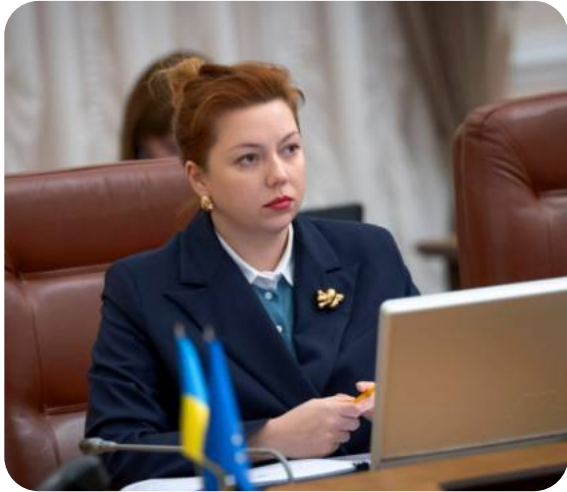

Increase of the Authorized Capital by UAH 240 million

In 2025, the Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine increased the authorized capital of the Energy Efficiency Fund by UAH 240 million, which made it possible to restore stable co-financing with international partners and attract additional donor funds for energy efficiency programs and housing recovery.

Meeting of the Coordination Council: Grant Policy of the “VidnovyDIM” Program Updated

In the summer, the X meeting of the Donors’ Coordination Council of the Energy Efficiency Fund took place, where key decisions for the further energy modernization of housing in Ukraine were discussed. The “VidnovyDIM” Program received an updated grant policy, providing increased funding, an expanded list of eligible measures, and coverage of technical support costs. The EU announced an additional €18 million in support, while partners from Germany and the IFC confirmed their readiness to continue cooperation.

The Energy Efficiency Fund, the State Agency on Energy Efficiency and Energy Saving of Ukraine, and the Decarbonization Fund of Ukraine have signed a memorandum of cooperation.

A new financial mechanism was presented: leasing of energy-efficient equipment with the possibility of receiving grants. This approach will help reduce the financial burden and increase the energy independence of buildings.

Record UAH 1.7 billion in payments under the “VidnovyDIM” program

The “VidnovyDIM” program is an effective tool for rapid housing restoration: over the past three years, more than 900 projects have already been completed, homeowners’ associations (HOAs) have received over UAH 1.7 billion in grants, and hundreds of thousands of Ukrainians have benefited from the support. The program, which provides 100% compensation of repair costs, proves that even during the war, recovery can be large-scale, fast, and genuinely capable of bringing people back to their homes.

Cooperation with the Decarbonization Fund: First Loan for HOAs

The launch of the joint mechanism enabled homeowners associations (HOAs) to obtain loans at a minimal interest rate to co-finance their share of projects under the Energy Efficiency Fund. This significantly reduced the financial burden on apartment owners.

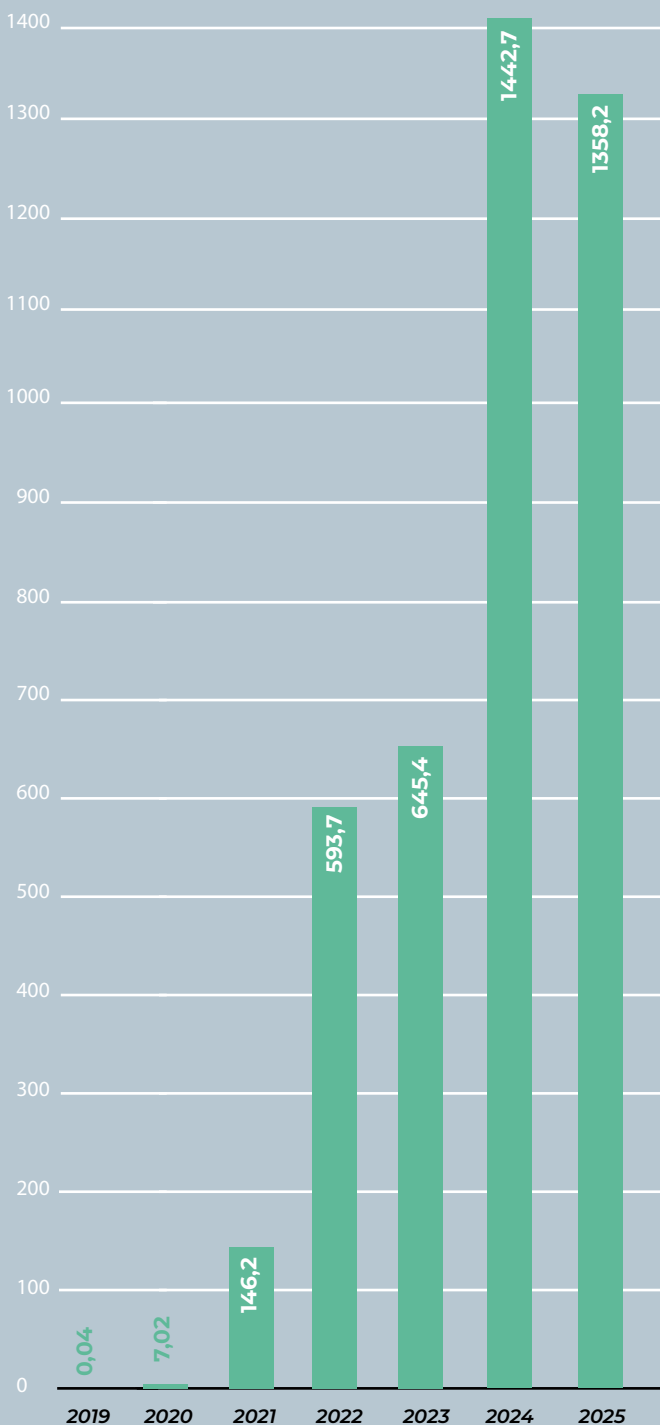

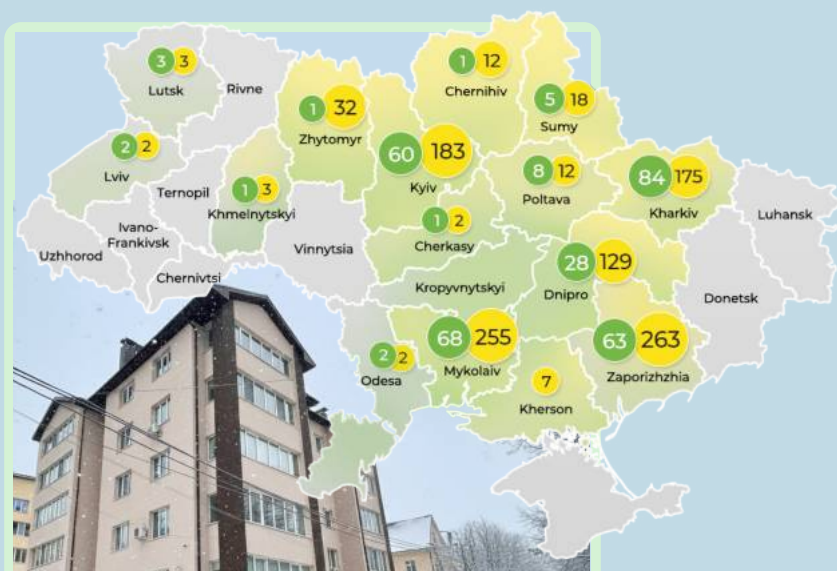

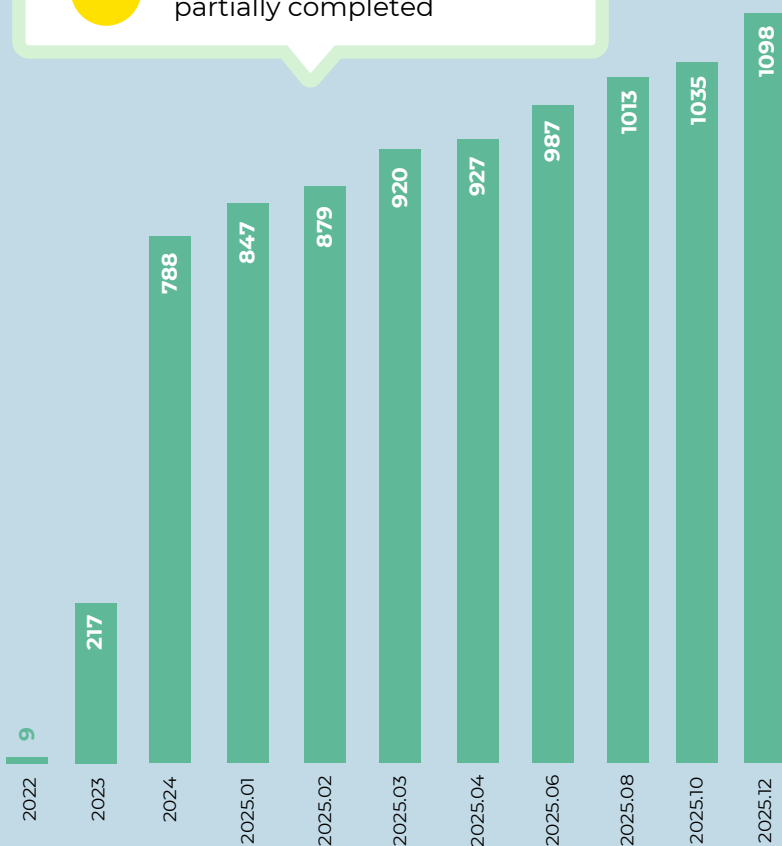

How an Ordinary Five-Story Multi-Apartment Building Became a Model of Energy Efficiency in Rivne



An ordinary five-story multi-apartment building in Rivne, where residents had long argued about which entrance was warmer, has become a true example of energy efficiency thanks to the participation of the homeowners' association "Rivne, Kyivska 28" in the "ENERGODIM" Program. Modernization of the heating networks and insulation of the building have provided even warmth, over 40% energy savings, and a level of comfort that residents previously thought was unattainable.

A 15 kW Solar Power System Installed on the Roof of the HOA "Urban House"

A 15 kW solar power system has been installed on the roof of the HOA "Urban House" multi-apartment building to supply electricity for common areas and elevator operation.

70% of the equipment cost was covered by the Energy Efficiency Fund under the "GreenDim" Program, 30% was funded by the local community budget, and residents only paid for the installation work.
