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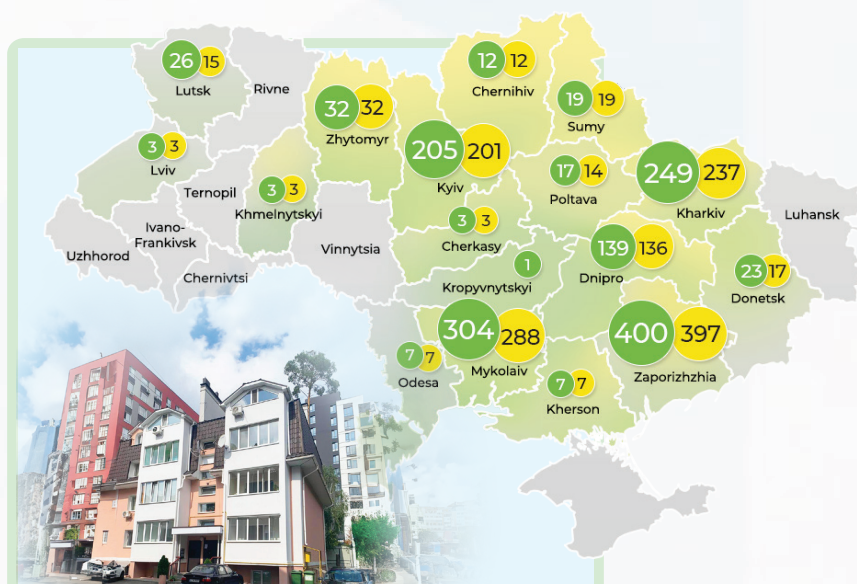

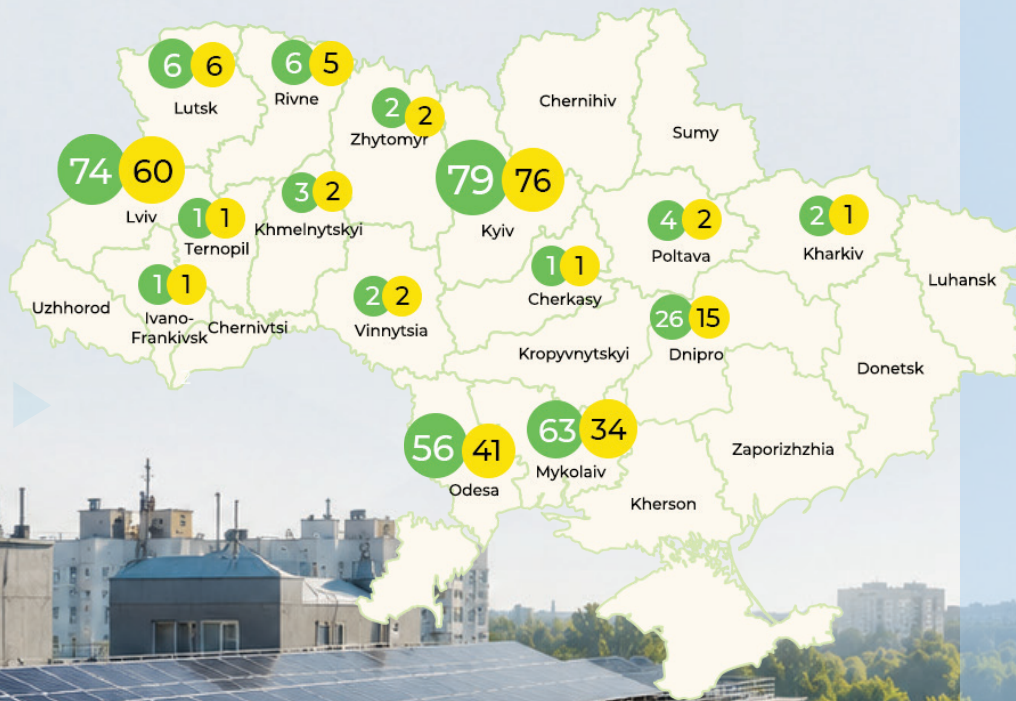
Up to 60% Energy Savings: the HOA "Edelweiss 24" in Kolomyia has Successfully Modernized Its Building under the Energodim Program
