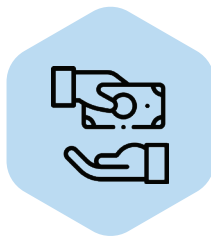
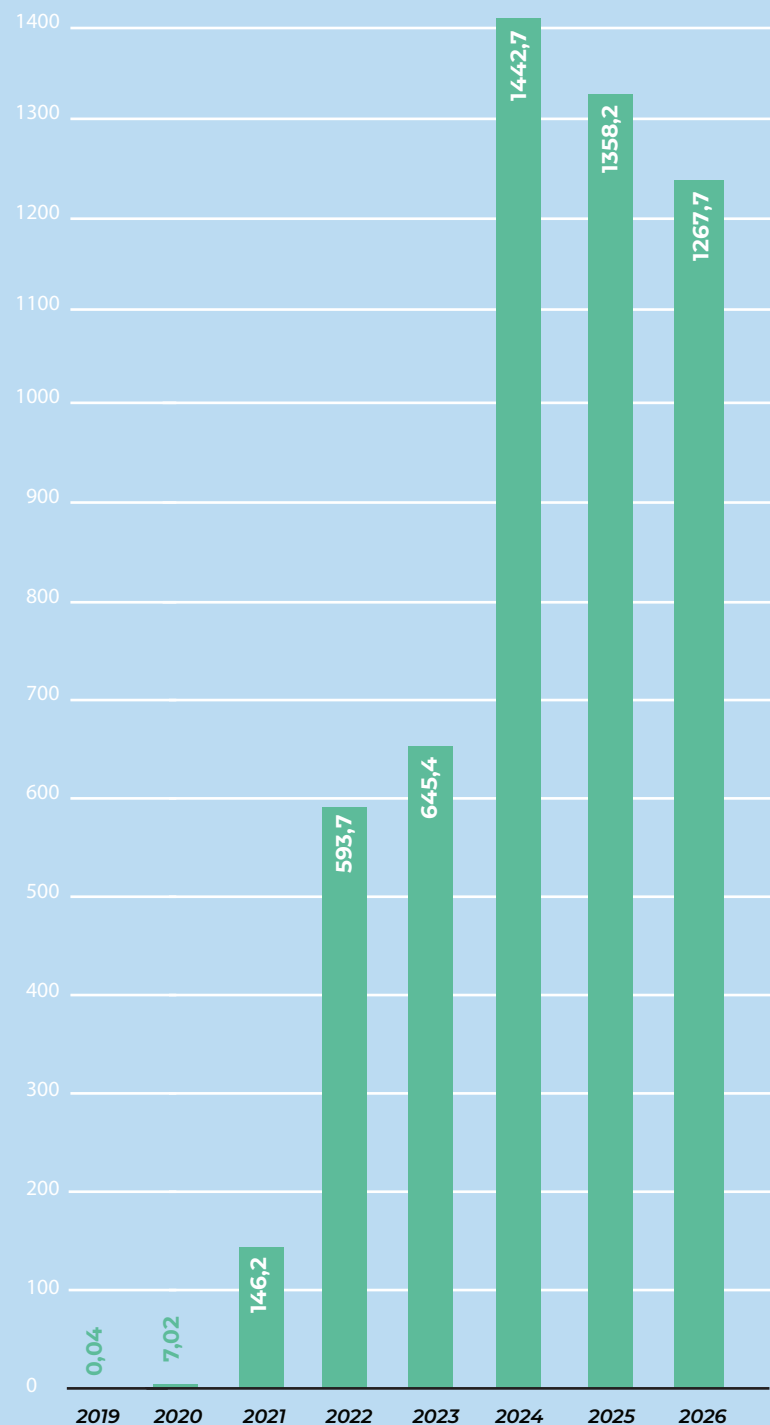

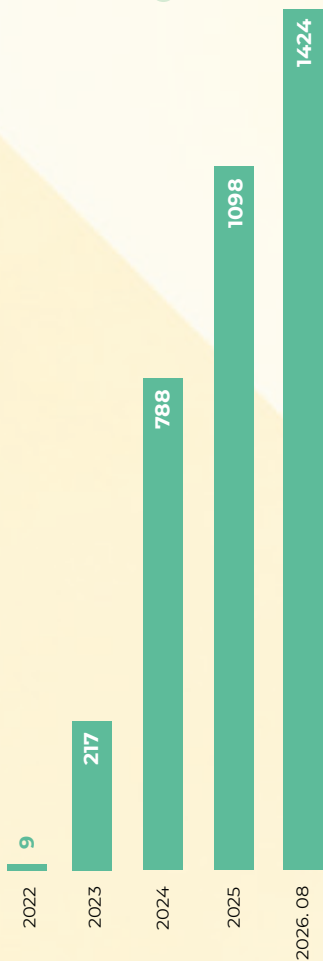

Nearly 400 Buildings Restored in Zaporizhzhia Region under the “VidnovyDIM” Program



Since the program was launched, HOAs in the Zaporizhzhia region have submitted 400 applications to restore damaged residential buildings, with 399 projects already fully or partially completed. The total value of the projects is UAH 860.5 million, of which the EEF has already paid UAH 655.5 million; the restored buildings are home to more than 54,000 families.

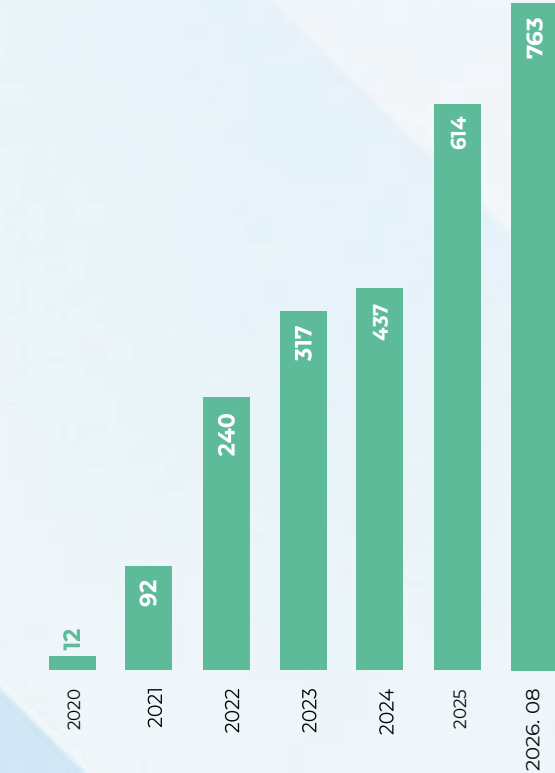

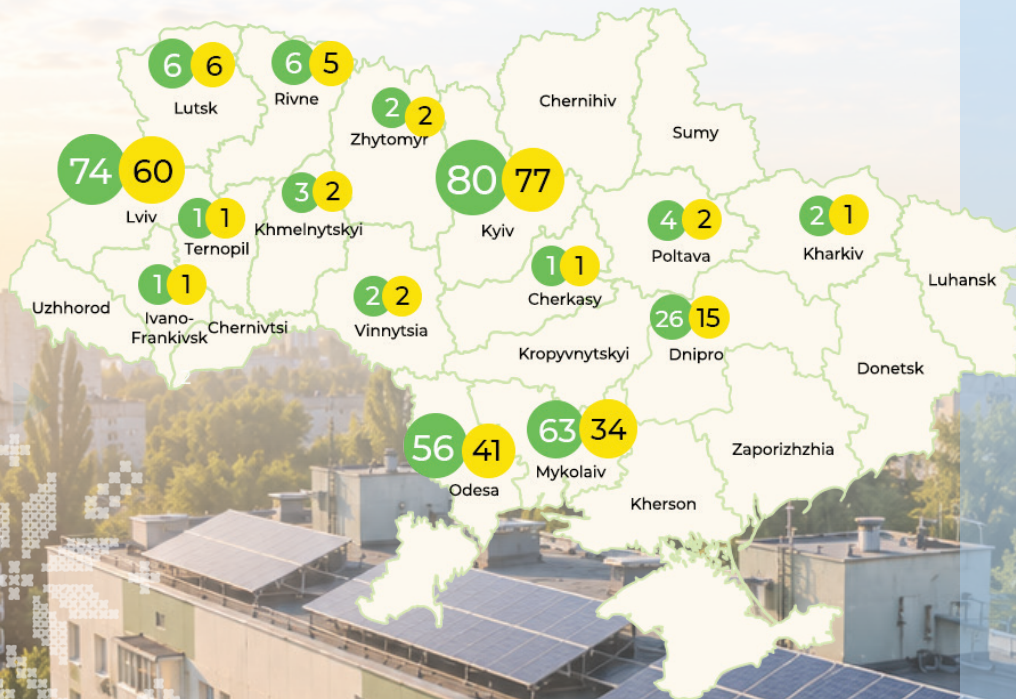
HOA “Vidinska, 2” in Rivne Improves Its Energy Efficiency Rating from G to C under the “Energodim” Program



The HOA “Vidinska, 2” in Rivne has completed a comprehensive modernization of its nearly 50-year-old apartment building under the “Energodim” Program. As a result, the building’s energy efficiency rating improved by four classes, from G to C, while energy consumption decreased from 147 to 79 kWh/m².
